

# EMERGENCY ©

*Assetco Vehicles Ltd v Kensington and Chelsea*  
(PATAS Case no.: 2050044376)

The vehicle was parked on a double yellow line where loading/unloading was prohibited. The Appellant contested liability on the basis that it claimed the vehicle was attending a gas emergency.

There was not apparently an exemption from the parking controls in those circumstances. Nevertheless, the tenor of the correspondence from the local authority was that it would be prepared, as a matter of discretion, to cancel the Penalty Charge Notice if the Appellant could show that the vehicle was attending an emergency.
