



**LOADING/UNLOADING

CODES & DESCRIPTIONS TAKEN FROM THE
LONDON PARKING ATTENDANTS' HANDBOOK

Contravention Codes and Descriptions

- 01 Parked in a restricted street during prescribed hours.
Loading Allowed
- 04 Parked in a meter bay when penalty time is indicated.
Loading Allowed
- 05 Parked after the expiry of paid for time at a pay and display or voucher bay. **Loading Allowed**
- 06 Parked without payment of the initial charge shown by a clearly displayed valid ticket or voucher. **Loading Allowed**
- 08 Parked at an out of order meter during controlled hours (electronic parking meters) **Loading Allowed**
- 15 Parked in a residents' parking space without clearly displaying a valid residents' parking permit. **Loading Allowed**
- 16 Parked in a permit parking space without displaying a valid permit. **Loading Allowed**
- 20 Parked in a loading gap marked by a yellow line.
Loading Allowed
- 22 Re-parked within one hour (or other specified time) of leaving a bay or space in the same parking place.
Loading Allowed
- 23 Parked in a parking place or area not designated for the class of vehicle. **Loading Allowed**
- 24 Not parked correctly within the markings of a bay or space. **Loading Allowed**

**Contravention Codes and Descriptions
(CONTINUED)**

- 30 Parked in a free parking place for longer than the maximum period. **Loading Allowed**
- 40 Parked in a designated disabled person's parking space without clearly displaying a valid disabled person's badge. **Loading Allowed**
- 42 Parked in a parking place designated for police vehicles. **Loading Allowed**
- 55 A commercial vehicle parked in a restricted street in contravention of the Overnight Waiting Ban. **Loading Allowed**
- 60 Parked on an urban road with one or more wheels resting on a footway, land between two carriageways, grass verge, garden or space. **Loading Allowed (but only if it cannot reasonably be carried out elsewhere)**
- 61 A heavy commercial vehicle wholly or partly parked on a footway, verge or land between two carriageways. **Loading Allowed (but only if it cannot reasonably be carried out elsewhere)**

(The Parking Attendants' Handbook has been devised after general consultation with London Boroughs to provide a standard approach to issuing Parking Charge Notices across London. It is accepted that there will be local variations in policy and these will be a matter for each borough.)
